## 2019 Premier's Reading Challenge

The Premier's Reading Challenge has begun for another year. The challenge aims to encourage a love of reading for leisure and pleasure in students, and to enable them to experience quality literature. We encourage all students to participate.

To complete the challenge students are required to read and record the required number of books for their year level. For example, Years 3 and 4 must read and record 20 books to complete the challenge.

Challenge	Number of books you must read	Minimum number of PRC books	Maximum number of Personal Choice books	PRC booklists you can read from
K-2	30	25	5	K-2, 3-4, 5-6, 7-9
3-4	20	15	5	3-4, 5-6, 7-9
5-6	20	15	5	5-6, 7-9

All recording of books is done via the DoE student portal (See below for the web address) Students must complete their online Student Reading Records by Friday 30<sup>th</sup> August, 2019.

Students are encouraged to borrow PRC books from the shelves marked PRC in the library. These books can be identified by a small coloured Premier's Reading Challenge sticker on the books spine. If you are unsure if a book is included in the challenge, please check the full book list available on the website
